JEWELLERY/ APPEARANCE

It has become increasingly fashionable for children to wear jewellery. This can be dangerous in school. NO rings, necklaces or bracelets are to be worn. Earrings, if worn, are limited to plain studs (no more than one per ear lobe).

These must be removed for P.E. and swimming. Make-up and nail varnish is not allowed. The only other permitted jewellery is a medical bracelet / necklace or a watch. However, **the school accepts no responsibility for any jewellery lost in school.**

HAIR

Hair that is shoulder length or longer is to be tied back at all times for all pupils. Inappropriate fashion statements, for example – haircuts including tramlines, steps, and patterns cut into the hair, gelled spiky styles, hair colouring, excessive hair gel, and extra jewellery, are considered to be non-school uniform and as such are not permitted.
